The Town of Hilton Head will be accepting State ATAX grant applications from organizations on Hilton Head Island wishing to receive grants from the two percent (2%) state accommodations tax fund. All interested applicants must attend a mandatory Accommodations Tax Grant Applicant Training Workshop.

Applications will be accepted between Monday, August 4, 2025 and Friday, September 5, 2025.

Applications will not be accepted or reviewed if a workshop has not been attended.

The Accommodations Tax Grant Applicant Training Workshops will cover how to complete the application, provide an overview of the applicant evaluation process, and reimbursement procedures and requirements. In addition, the workshops will provide an opportunity for applicants to ask questions and share comments and feedback relating to the ATAX Grant application and process.

A quorum of the Accommodations Tax Advisory Committee may result if four or more committee members attend the workshops. No official business will be conducted.
