The Town of Hilton Head Island will be accepting State ATAX grant applications from Hilton Head Island organizations wishing to receive grants from the two percent (2%) state accommodations tax fund.

Applications will be accepted between
Wednesday, July 1, 2026 and Friday, July 31, 2026.

All interested applicants must register for and attend one of the mandatory Accommodations Tax Grant Applicant Training Workshops to be eligible for consideration.

These workshops will provide an overview of how to complete the application, the evaluation process, and the reimbursement procedures and requirements. Attendees will also have an opportunity to ask questions and share comments and feedback relating to the ATAX Grant application and process.

A quorum of the Accommodations Tax Advisory Committee may result if four or more committee members attend the workshops. No official business will be conducted.
